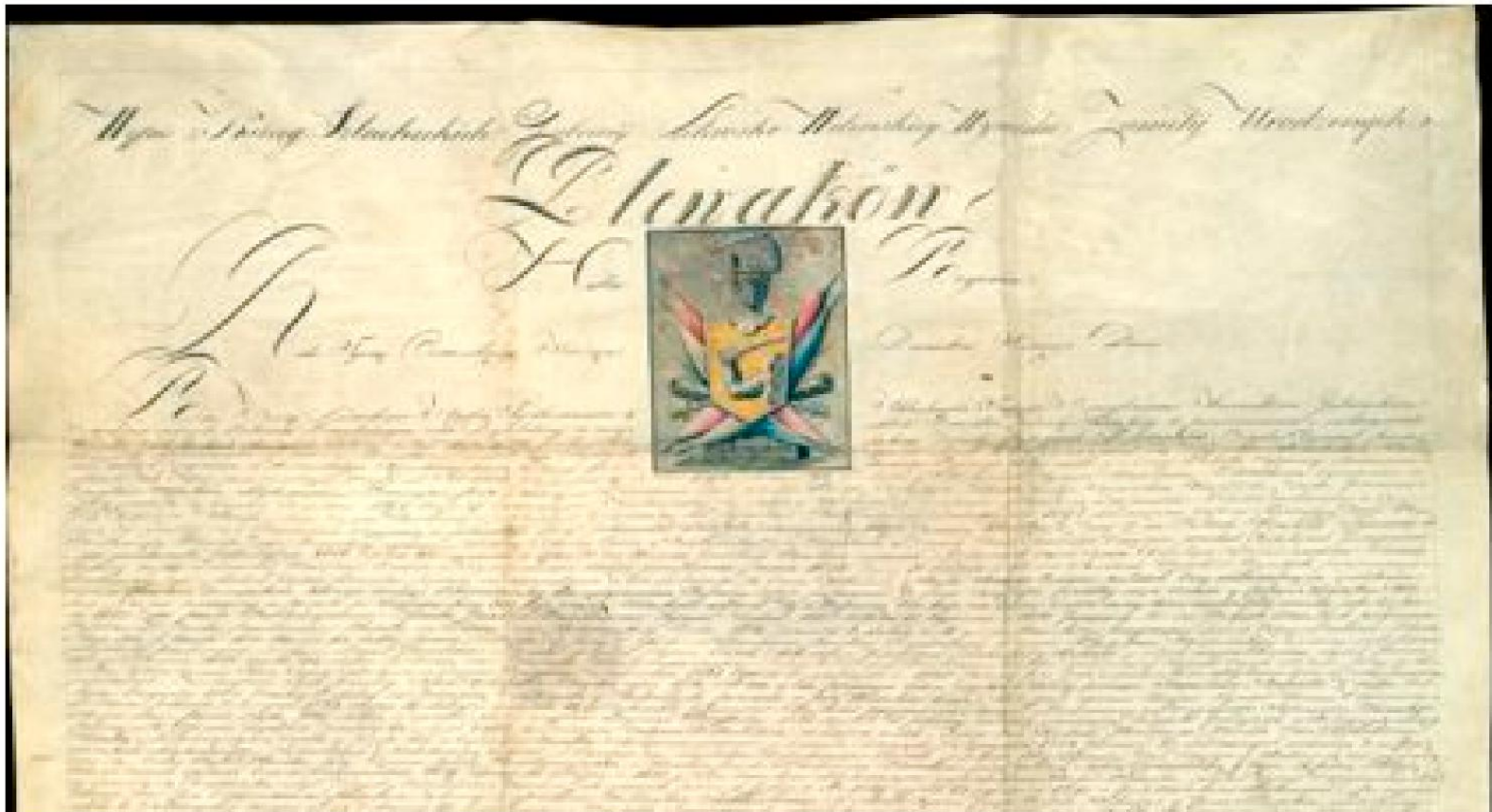

Mora. In red field floating and right with the head of a Moor hull ends to perception chest, with a white bandage around the forehead; Helmet decoration: three ostrich feathers. The coat of arms came from Italy with Wenancyusz , Bishop of Kruszwic

1034 to Poland, where his brother or brother's son stayed. head of the negro should be shoulder-high, turned black in the right shield, on the field with a red binda , girded with a black binda , ie white, in a helmet, three ostrich feathers.

The coat of arms that was brought from abroad to Poland, came up with the Venantjusz -Bischof Kruszwicki or (as we now call Kujawski, he entered this cathedral 1034. He came from there He

In the red area of the shield - heraldic right side - the head of the Negro turned and shown on the shoulders - tied with a white collar - twisted and tied at the neck . There are three ostrich feathers in the jewel .

Heraldic varieties

The Mora coat of arms comes in different varieties . In addition to the one described above , there is also, among other versions of the coat of arms - (Mora III), where the golden disc is the

shape of a black man in the right opposite side , with a white bandage on his head , dressed in a tunic , hold a tight bow with an arrow - aimed at the top of

the slope . About the sign , the jewel on the helmet ( without crown , s Rank ) two shots silver showed no bleeding , showed on the top of the slope . In addition, there

is a variant of the Mora coat of arms above ( calling ) - Sulicki I and Sulicki II.

The creation of the coat of arms :

Mora ( German . Mohr) is arms with origin from Germany and well-known Polish coat of arms as early as the eleventh century . Bartosz Paprocki quotes the " Herby Knighthood Polish " - Latin text for

the Bishop of Włocławek Andrew from 1034. Where there is a description of his coat of arms . The oldest seal of the act

of judicial comes up only in 1412 Mora Herb occurs most often in the Mazovia region .
