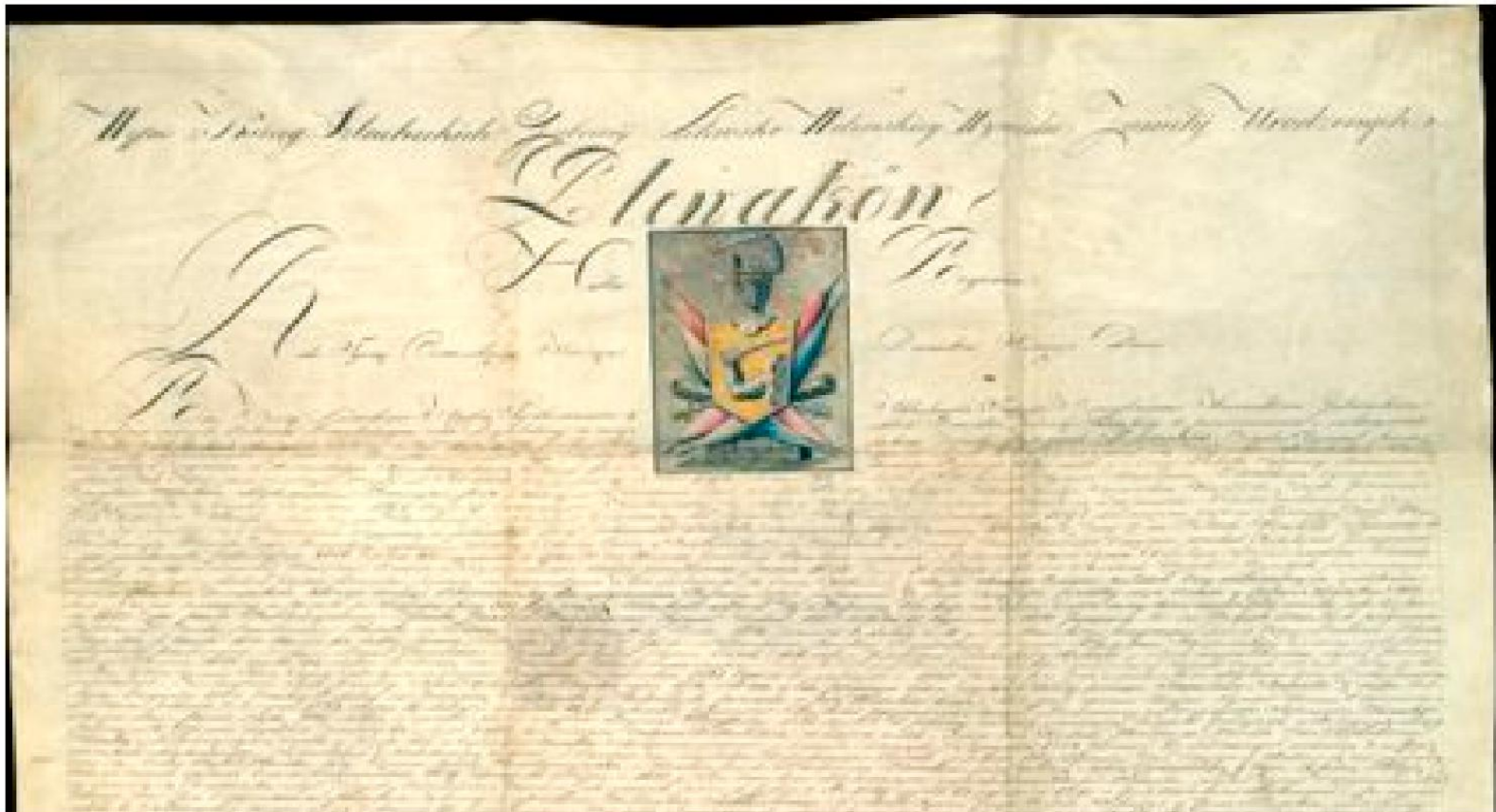

### **Die adlige polnische Familie Achinger.**

Achinger . In a golden field on green floor rotates a squirrel-fitting; Helmet decoration: an identical squirrel between two. black elephant trunks. It invaded Germany in 1547. The same leads die: Achinger , Adamski, Barwinski , Berwinski , Ichnatowski , Pilchowski , Ryczewski .

Achinger (Aichinger, Ajchinger , Ajchigier , Bażyński , Wiewiórka ), Polish coat of arms of German origin.

### **Description of the coat of arms**

In the golden field, a red squirrel with a fluffy tail on its back. There are two trumpets in the jewel and the same squirrel between them. Orgelbrand and Znamierowski report that golden labras are lined with red. [1

### **Earliest records**

The coat of arms of German origin appeared in Poland in the middle of the 15th century.

The coat of arms is most widespread in the country of Sieradz , in the Duchy of Oświęcim and in the Duchy of Zator .

## **Description of the coat of arms**

In the golden field sits a red squirrel with a fluffy tail on its back. In the jewel there is an emblem between two deer horns.

## **Achinger III**

Achinger III (Aichinger III, Kieystucz ), Polish noble coat of arms, variation of the Achinger coat of arms.

## **Blazoning**

At the waist. The upper field is a pole, on the right there is a silver tower in the red field, on the left a red squirrel sits in the gold field on a green tri- hill. Four slants in the lower field: silver, red, gold and black. Jewel: Between two eagle wings, the right one in a white and red belt, the left one in a black and gold belt, an armed knight with a pole in his right hand and a gold apple in his left. Labry on the right red, lined with silver, on the left black, lined with gold.

- Note: Alfred Znamierowski gives the right wing in the jewel everything red.

## **The earliest records of Herbownia**

Achinger coat of arms. This is how Paprocki o Herb described it. fol . 587. Okolski track. 1. fol . 15. Liber Jewels fol . 36. Potocki in the mail of coat of arms. MS. P. Rutka . To the right of the coat of arms, a red squirrel with white breasts runs in a golden field with its tail raised on its back. the squirrel sits above the coat of arms as if between two horns: but Okolski (whom I saw) on the helmet says that between [p. 11] with two deer horns that sat as if sitting, but turned their head back and turned to the left of the coat of arms.

The authors are silent about the beginning of this jewel; However, they agree that the foreign writers von Eenghinger , who were brought to Poland from Germany in 1455, place among the first Austrian gentlemen the most important in a special grace Ladislaus of Bohemia and the Hungarians, some of whom pretended to reject the king out of respect, disturbed by the court.
