Antoni Gieppert, ennobled on the Sejm of 1775, received a diploma and the coat of arms of Kotwica (MP.) in 1783. Antoni Geppert, royal secretary in the years 1782-1787 (DW. 98 f. 828 and 1206; 103 f. 1028), became an advocate for the poor at assessors and people's courts in 1775 (Kancl. 55 f. 137). Stanisław Geppert, son of the above, born of Maryanna née Sakres, had a peerage in the kingdom in 1837 (files of former Her.). Antoni's daughters: Józefa Fabianowa Laskowska, widow and Maryanna, virgin 1817.

Adam, the heir of Nawra, has a case with Wolski (A. Tryb Piotrk.) in 1633-1640. Andrzej bought the sum of Drohojowska in 1634 (Gr. Sanoc. 60 f. 502). Mikołaj of Polków bought half of Wólka Boryszowska, also known as Żórawie mud, in the principality from Dunin in 1686 (Gr. Krak. 306 f. 898). Anna of Bieniakowa, 1st BC Franciszkowa Konopacka, 2nd from Adamowa Komorowska, 3rd BC Teodorowa Grodzicka, gave the sum in 1681, Michał Konopacki (Gr. Sanoc. 78 f. 213) Kazimierz recognized Komorowska 1670 r. (Gr. Sanoc 101 f. 145). Jan von Polków, son of Wojciech, Trembowelski from 1703, issued a power of attorney in Lublin in 1710 for himself and his wife Judyta von Wilczopolska (Kyiv VIII f. 1190 and 1192; vol. XI f. 976) . His first wife was Regina née Kaszowska, Duchess Stefanowa Czetwertyńska. His children: Dominik, Adam, Józef and Judyta (Woł. XII f. 256 and Bracł. XVI f. 1041). Dominik from Polków examined Stempkowski in 1731, and in 1736 he received half of Holuzia and Wólka Holuzyjska from the Krasicki family (Vol. XII f. 522). He married Maryanna Rohozińska (Bracł. XVI f. 475) in 1736 and left two sons: Adam and Józef Leon. Adam, from the Volhynia Voivodeship, Elector of Stanisław August, from the smaller army, became the Kremenets Swordfish in 1774, and after the appointment failed, in 1776 he became the Kremenets Great Army. He died in 1782. From Fortunata Boguszevska, his son Ignacy Floryan died childless. Józef Leon, heir of Hołuzia, Starost of Głuchów, Elector of Stanisław August, married in 1st BC with Antonina Peretyatkowiczówna, in the 2nd from with the widow of Stempkowski Rohozińska, left sons: Prokop Ignacy and Mateusz. A) Prokop Ignacy married Ludwika Grabowska and had sons by her: Antoni, Szymon Ewaryst

and Franciszek Joachim Kalikst. 1). Antoni, married to Ksawera Teleżyńska, left daughters: Kassylda Leonowa Konopacka, Aleksandra and Apolonia Cielecka, and son Józef Gustaw Roch, heir of Woronek, married in 1st BC. with Antonina Cieszkowska, in the 2nd from with Leopolda Konopacka, wives, daughter of Walerya , after Karol Zaleski, and on the other side - sons: Wojciech Antoni and Gustaw Karul, with nobility cards in Volhynia 1891 2). Szymon Ewaryst, born 1790 owner of Ławrynowce, where he died in 1884, writer and poet, deputy, then Zwiachel Chamberlain, 1844 President of the Volyn Civil Chamber. In 1826 he married Klementyna Łaznińska, chamberlain of Ostroh, whose daughters: Otolia, 1. v. Lasotova, 2nd B.C. Będzińska, Stanisława Czarnołaska and Zofia, 1st BC Lasotova, 2nd B.C. Pilchowska, and sons: 1. Wiktor Szymon, married to Kamilla Zwolska, whose sons: Witold Paulin Franciszek, married to Dubiecka and Kazimierz Hipolit. 2. Prokop Wincenty Szymon, married to Olizarówna, has a son Antoni. 3. Józef Szymon, née Kadłubska, has a son, Ignacy, who is married to Podgorodnikówna. 4. Lukasz Henryk Szymon. 3). Franciszek Joachim Kalikst, third son of Prokop Ignacy, born 1799 married the owner of Ihnatek and Gisowszczyzna Zofia Przyłuska, whose sons: 1. Konstanty Maryan, born 1831, by Aleksandryna Sienicka, has a daughter, Marya. 2. Władysław, born 1833 and 3. Jerzy Szymon Modest, born 1836 settled in Dresden, where in 1875 they were awarded the title of counts. B) Mateusz, younger son of Józef Leon, Starost of Głuchów, heir of Hołuzia, married in 1st BC with Tekla Faszczewska, in the 2nd from with Tekla Wilczopolska, from the latter he had two sons: Leon Prokop and Ludwik, and a daughter, Ksawera, 1-for v. Rakowska, 2-for v. Kuwicyńska. Leon Prokop, the heir of Hołuzia, married Kassylda Konopacka, whose sons: 1. Jan Maciej Przemysław, married to Marya Duninówna, has: Bohdan, Wanda and Marya; and 2.

Włodzimierz Tadeusz Wincenty, whose descendants: Jan, Marya Zofia, Bolesław and Kazimierz. Ludwik, heir of Wólka Holuzyjska, married to Felicja Zaleska, heiress of Boguszówka, among them: Kazimierz Aleksander, heir of Boguszówka and Zygmunt, heir of Wólka Holuzyjska. Those Konopacki who are legally recognized as nobility in the Volyn Governorate are indicated by Żychliński as belonging to the Konopacki from Konopat with the Konopacki coat of arms, as well as those we will talk about below. Andrzej Konopacki, née Barbara Podolska, had a son, Grzegorz Stanisław, married to Anna Dzwonkowska, whose son Jan married Jadwiga Wasilkowska and went off with their two sons: Stefan and Andrzej. 1. Stefan, married to Maryanna Brzezowska, whose sons: Father Maciej, Father Uherecki, Michał. Mortgage holders of Wierzchnikowce, Floryan and Szymon, heirs of Daszówka and Ignacy, with nobility certificate and Trzaska coat of arms in 1782, at the Sanok Municipal Court. From the mentioned sons of Stefan, Michał, he had from Balbina Gruzewska: a) Maciej, married to Klementyna Ostrowska, daughter of Klemens and Tekla, whose son was Mieczysław Hipolit Tytus. B) Jan Karol, whose son Ludwik, a lieutenant in the Austrian army, born of Konstancja Czarkowska, proved his nobility in the Galician National Department in 1863. 1778 Andrzej His uncle, nephew Michał and Wiktorya nee Witwicki, widow of Stefan, a Jewish cupbearer, sued Szawłowski for lease of Wołkowice (A. Jan of Glewo, son of Mikołaj, Elector of Jan III. from the Dobrzyń region and August II from the Czersk region, Chalice from Łuków 1680, founder of the Marian Monastery in Goźlin, where he built a church and a monastery in 1699, bought part of Goźlin in 1676 and 1677, sued Leżeński in 1677 and against in 1679 Paris, supported his sister Magnuszewska in 1682, bought back part of Goźlin from Narzyski in 1692 and signed the Boglewski Trial in 1698. His first wife, Cecylia née Rongiusz, widow of Konstanty Parys, a Cześnik Czersnik, wrote 4,000 flores in Gąski in 1698. Marian priest, and in 1700 she renounced the inheritance of her brother Tomasz, canon of Łuck, to her sister Katarzyna Kazimierzowa Orlikowa. Jan bequeathed his second wife Katarzyna Ludwika Żernicka in 1704 to life imprisonment, bound in 1705 as a widow in Goźlin. She kept Kaniewo and Jerzmanowo in Brzesko for life, which the Lasocki family shared after her death in 1725 (Perp. Czers. 13 f. 470, 540, 624 and 686; 14 A f. 13 and 42; 14 B f. 14; 14 C 131; 15 f. 91, 281 and 528; 16 B f. 379; 17 f. 315; Zs. Warec. 31 f. 102; Zap. Lub. 60 f. 408).

Ferdinand von Glewo, son of Mikołaj, Elector of King Michał from the Czersk region, together with his brother Konstanty sold part of Guzówek to brother Jan in 1693 (Perp. Czers. 14 C f. 163).

Konstanty von Glewo, son of Mikołaj, Elector of Augustus II of Czersk Land, also called Łuków Cup in 1721, judge of the Radom Tribunal in 1713, married to Katarzyna Ostrowska, whom he sentenced to life imprisonment in 1689, and she renounced for his mother and his brothers on paternity (Perp. Czers. 14 A f. 40 and 414; 18 f. 22), he paid 1,500 guilders to Lesznowski in 1692; with his brother Ferdynand he sold part of Guzówek to his brother Jan in 1693. In 1701 he made a contract with Wysockimi and in 1711 he secured with his sister-in-law Janowa dowry for his daughters: Cecylia, wife of Paweł Słanka and Anna , still unmarried in 1711 and later wife of Antoni Górski, a carpenter in Zakroczym in 1721, he made

a compromise with Magnuszewski and in 1730 bought Goźlino Podleśne from Myszczyński. His sons Józef and Wojciech have various minor affairs in the years 1713-1724. Józef, known as Teacup of Łuków in 1734, accepted a charter from his future wife, Marjanna née Lisicki Nietyksina, in 1733, and with this wife he demonstrated against Przyłuski in 1734, in 1736 he was tied up in Pitalew, and his wife in 1734. in Żabieniec. In 1733 he headed the Goźlin department with his brother Wojciech and in 1751 with his cousin Kazimierz and daughters after Stanisław. Their only daughter, Katarzyna, the wife of the Czerski writer Baltazar Jasieński, and his widow were taken by Goźlin in 1771. Life records 1733 with his wife Joanna Sławęcka, who was confirmed as a widow along with his brother-in-law Józef by Czartoryski in 1743, and with this brother-in-law and his daughter Zuzanna in 1744 by Słanka. In 1747 Zuzanna married Antoni Piasecki, a hunter from Braclaw. The same, it seems, because in 1786 Zuzanna is the widow of Wojciech Popławski, a hunter from Braclaw. In fact, on January 3, 1752 in Warsaw, Dobrzyń's cupbearer married Popławski, a Jewish Stolnikowicz. The wedding was given by Fr. Ostrowski, chancellor of Kraków and administrator of Warsaw (Perp. Kazimierz von Glewo, Tomasz's fourth son, distinguished himself during his service in the Florentine army in the war with the Turks, for which he was awarded the St. Stephen's after conducting a nobility dispute approved by King Władysław on June 4, 1645. Then he returned to the countryside and here in 1649 bought part of Śniadków from his brother Mikołaj and in 1651 attested a résumé with his wife Anna née Lesiewska Mładzka (Perp. Czers. 11 f. 217 and 460),

with whom she in 1656 died of the plague. Stephan of her sons was captured in Żórawno; Maksymilian died in 1678 in Constantinople, where he traveled in the entourage of the envoy from Gniński; Valerian left only descendants. In 1678 Walerjan concluded a contract of inheritance for himself and for his brothers with his uncle Mikołaj for uncle Jan, testified in 1681 with his wife Teresa Magnuszewska together with his cousin Jan who Cześnik Łuków bought 1685. Part of Zalesie died on 8 October 1691 and left four sons, heirs of Goźlin Górny and Podleśny and Śniadków Dolny: Stanisław, Antoni, Kazimierz and Jan, who died childless in 1729, the last of whom is brought to the city of Czersk by the other brothers (Perp. Czers. 13 f. 589 , 613 and 727; 14 A f. 45, 130 and 189; 18 f. 350; 21 f. 142; 35 f. 177 ). Stanisław, son of Walerjan, witnessed a life sentence in 1716 with his wife, Franciszka née Służewska, with whom he met P

Niewski 1737, bound 1729 in Śniadków Dolny and in Goźlin Górny, owned by his widow 1749. After Stanisław only four daughters remained: Salome, 1748, the widow of Piotr Tyborowski, and the wife of 2. v. Antoni Rembowski, treasurer Zakroczymski in 1755; Bogumiła, the wife of 1st BC Ignacy Witkowski, who died in 1751, and 2nd B.C. Seweryn Grebecki 1753; Joanna, wife of Stanisław Lubiejewski 1757 and Marjanna, 1st BC After Piotr Goźliński, died 1758, and 2. BC. After Franciszek Trzeciński 1758 (DW. 62 f. 964; Perp. Czers. 21 f. 123; 23 B f. 489 and 679; 24 f. 269; 29 f. 128 and 519; 30 f. 121, 204, 205 and 372; 31 f. 10, 40, 95, 208 and 398; 34 f. 298; 35 p. 301; 37 p. 141; Deb. Czers. 1 p. 58, 64 and 128; 3 p. 50). Fabjan appears in 1780 as the closest relative of this Marjanna Trzecińska and confirms the sale of part of Goźlin to Jasiński (Perp. Czers. 36 f. 241). Antoni, son of Walerjan, in 1723 testified a life legacy with Marjanna Myszczyńska, heiress of Cybulice, whom she sold to Cybulski in 1731, and in 1743 Magnuszew was taken over by the widow. Her sons

Stanisław, the sub-delegate from Opoczno and Kasper, the sub-delegate from Radom, sold part of Śniadków Górny in 1758. Stanisław is a pastor in Skrzynno in 1762 and in Wrzos in 1774. This Kasper, perhaps the son of Idzi Joachim Mateusz, came from the nobility in the kingdom in the first half of the 19th century (UW. 65 f. 354 and 413; 68 f. 151; Perp. Czers. 22 f. 109; 26 f. 197; 29 f. 596; 31 f. 38 and 373). Kazimierz, son of Walerjan, signed by the Żukowski family in 1741, died in 1757 when his widow Teresa née Sobiekurska and their daughters Marjanna and Jozafata were tied in Śniadków Dolny. Kazimierz's widow married Kasper Trzeciński in 1764. Of the daughters: Marjanna, who died unmarried; Jozefata was married to Józef Dobiecki in 1777 (Perp. Czers. 25 p. 288; 30 p. 447; 32 p. 51 and 287; 34 p. 194; 35 p. 279 and 301; 36 p. 206; Deb. Czers 1 f. 32, 58 and 135; 3 f. 40, 49 and 52). Jan von Glewa, fifth son of the chamberlain of Dobrzyń, born 1522, heir of Głowczyn in the Dobrzyń region, 1564, from his wife Lubieniecka, had sons: Aleksander, who died young, and Jan, twice married, left with his first Mrs. Zofja Zakrzewska, son of Stanisław, childless, and daughter Zofja, after Samuel Plichta and on the other hand Jadwiga Brańska von Branno, Ewa, married 1st vice in Wylazłów on November 12, 1637 to Zygmunt Grochowalski and 2nd vice to Stanisław Żelski from Chalin; Katarzyna according to Wojciech Rościszewski from Skrzynno; Marjanna after Walenty Piniński; Anna after Stanisław Stępczyński, who died in 1646; John, who died young; Alexander, heir of Wylazłów, Elector Władysław IV, died in 1646, buried in Dobrzyń and Wojciech. Wojciech, heir of Glewo, Głowczyn and Wylazłów, elector of Władysław IV, married to Elżbieta Plichcianka, the standard ensign of Sochaczew, appointed in 1652 and 1659 to take care of the children, with his brothers' cousins and Wacław, the standard bearer of Wyszogród, died on 12. 1660 Their daughter Elżbieta, born on January 21, 1652 to Jan Lubicz Orłowski from Orłów on Wielgie and Zaduszniki, died

childless in 1659. Wojciech had four sons: Kazimierz fought against the Swedes and died on July 25, 1656 in the plague camp, buried with the Saint Bernards in Warsaw. Mikołaj graduated from the Jesuit schools in Płock in 1654 and was murdered by the Swedes in 1658. Stanisław was brought to Lithuania by relatives and accommodated at the railway station of Hlebowicz, Smolensk voivode, returned to school in Płock and became a Jesuit in 1650, he stayed in Hungary where he was ordained, returned to the country in 1663, became a confessor in 1671 of King Michael, completed the family year started by his great-grandfather and wrote down the family history in Vilnius in 1678. Idzi Wojciech, Wojciech's youngest son, married in February 1672 under the care of Jan, vicar of Szydłów, heir of Glewa and Wylazłowa, Elector of Jan III in 1678 had daughters: Elżbieta and Katarzyna, then sons: Wojciech and Antoni. Of them Elżbieta married Krzysztof Karski and together with her brothers and her mother in 1696 fell in Płock of election 1733, left the hospital in 1737, he was heir of Glew in 1732 (Zap. Gr. Płoc. 141 f. 163 and 570; 155 f. 60; 162 f. 518; Herb. Król. Pol. ). In 1755 his widow, Teresa née Działyńska, with her children Antonina Hieronimowa Sierakowska, a hunter from Krzemieniec and Jakób, had a case in Płock. In addition to Jakób, there was also Idzia's son who, as the Dobrzyń cupbearer, with his wife Helena Zembrzuska, a writer from Sochaczew, signed the Leszczyński election in 1733 with the Dobrzyn Land. your mo

that the son was Jacenty Lasocki, heir of Glew in 1825 (Zap. Grodz. Płock. 197 f. 662; 200 f. 383; 203 f. 268; DW. 96 f. 481; 103 f. 946; 105 f. 812). ; Herb King of Poland; Cor.). Apart from the Lasocki family, which is connected in a family tree, there are many more, to which branch they belong, be it from Brzeziny or Glewo. or from lasocin. About these messages at the end of the article I will mention only a few who wrote from Glewo, so they come
