

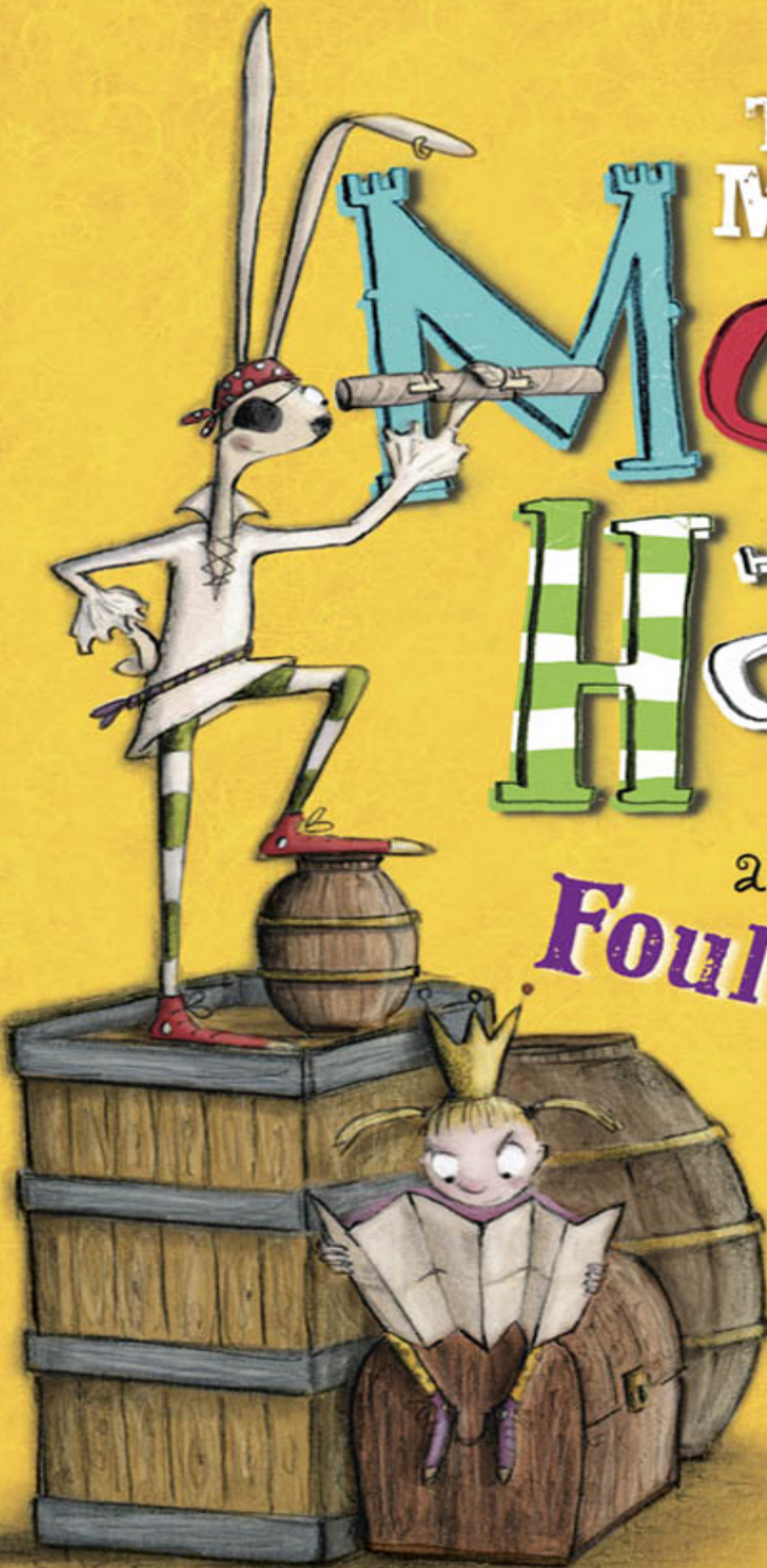

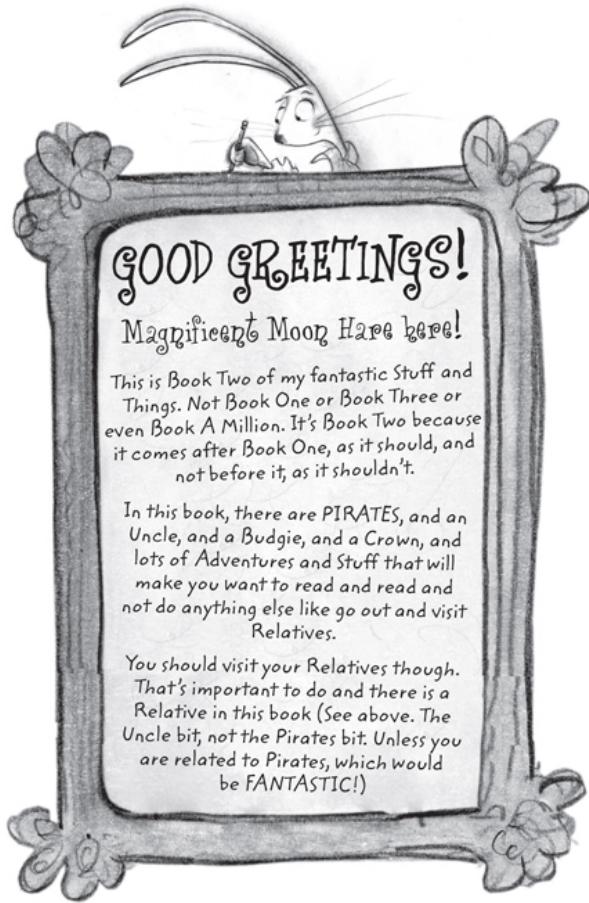

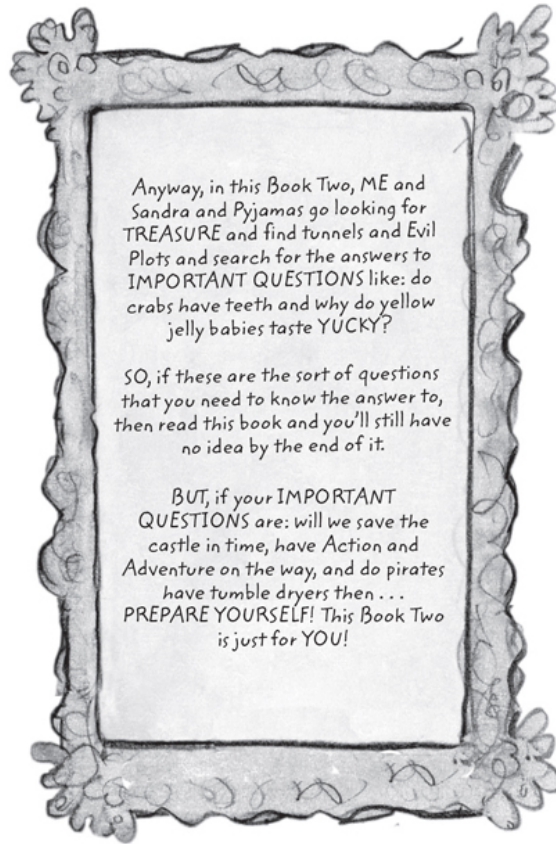
GOOD GREETINGS!

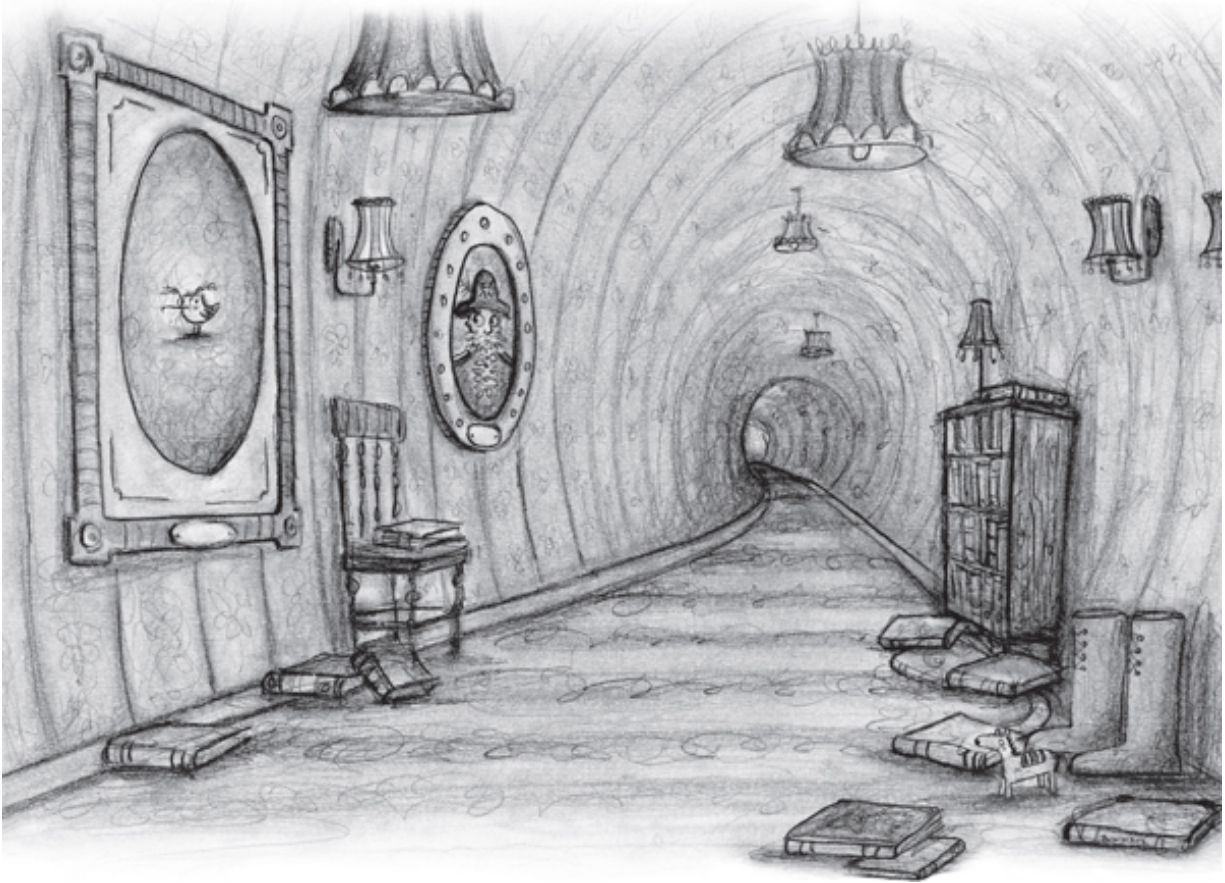


EGMONT LUCKY COIN
